Miami Southridge Senior High School is a mandatory uniform school. The dress code was established in order to set the tone for an academic atmosphere in which students and faculty can function in a safe environment without distraction.

| SHIRTS | <p>Polo shirt with collar and sleeves Solid Colors Only: Red, Black, Grey, or White</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Southridge Logo is optional <p>Sweatshirt/Hoodie with Southridge Logo (purchased from Southridge)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Red, Black, Grey, or White <p>Spirit Shirts (School issued club and athletic t-shirts)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May be worn on the last day of the week ONLY • Must be school colors and have Southridge/Spartan logo) • May be worn with jeans. |
| PANTS | <p>Fitted, long uniform pants worn at the waist with a belt (no denim) Solid Colors Only: Khaki, Black</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO jeans, shorts, capris, sweatpants, tights, leggings or jeggings (Jeans may be worn on the last day of the week with a Spirit Shirt). • NO holes or shredded fabric. • NO sagging pants. Pants must be worn at their original length and fitted at the waist with no visible undergarments |
| UNDERSHIRTS | <p>Solid Colors Only: Red, Black, Grey, or White</p> |
| JACKETS | <p>Zipper or Button Front jackets, sweaters and senior jerseys MUST be worn over the required polo shirt.</p> <p>Solid Colors Only: Red, Black, Grey, or White</p> |
| SHOES | <p>Closed shoes only (no sandals, flip flops, or open toes) Shoes must have backs, no spontaneous fabrications (ie. rubber bands, ribbons)</p> |
| STUDENT ID | <p>Must be available upon request.</p> |

The following items MAY NOT BE WORN:

- NO hats or hoods may be worn in any building or classroom.
- NO headwear of any kind: headbands, mesh head coverings, bandanas, handkerchiefs, do-rags, hair curlers, combs, and hair picks. These items MAY NOT be brought to school.
- NO sleep wear, bedroom shoes, pajamas, or slippers.
- NO dog collars, motorcycle chains, two or three finger rings, or spikes.
- NO colors, symbols, national pendants or items associated with gangs (this includes bandanas and flags made with beads).
- NO trench coats.
- NO sunglasses may be worn in the building.
