CRITERIA FOR CLUBS

- ◆ Must meet at least twice a month
- ◆ Must complete and submit a monthly report as per the schedule
- ◆ School and Community Service Requirements
 - ◆ 1 school project per month
 - ◆ 2 school beautification projects per year (if requested by admin).
 - ◆ 1 community service project per semester (**non-service clubs**)
 - ◆ 2 community service projects per 9 weeks (**service clubs**)
 - ◆ These are minimums
- ◆ Must participate in all school spirit events

ACTIVITY BUS

- ◆ Have your interested students put their name on the attached sign-up sheet.
- ◆ Submit on or before October 4.
- ◆ The bus will pick up every day at 5:15 p.m.

CLUB OF THE YEAR AWARD / POINTS

- ◆ Points are earned for a variety of activities including, but not limited to:
 - ◆ Posters for sporting events
 - ◆ Wearing red socks on pep rally days and Fridays (must sign roster during lunch at the Activities Office).
 - ◆ Wearing club t-shirts on pep rally days and Fridays (must sign roster during lunch at the Activities Office).
 - ◆ Dressing up on spirit days (signing roster at the Activities Office)
 - ◆ Community service projects
 - ◆ Anything that benefits the school or the community
- ◆ The following awards are given at the award ceremony at the end of the year (based on points earned).
 - ◆ Club of the Year
 - ◆ Club Spirit
 - ◆ Club Service Award
- ◆ Points can only be awarded if the monthly reports are **submitted on time.**

 - ◆ Mandatory – Clubs will be assigned a location.

- ◆ Fall Frolics October 17 at 6:30 p.m.
 - ◆ Application due October 4

 - ◆ All clubs must participate as performers or paying audience members (or both)

OPEN HOUSE

- ◆ September 26.
- ◆ All clubs and performing groups are required to have a table set-up at the Resource Fair.
- ◆ A separate memo is forthcoming.

PEP RALLIES

- ◆ Clubs should show **extraordinary** spirit at pep rallies and other spirit events.
- ◆ This means **STANDING UP** and **HOLDING HANDS** while **SINGING** the Alma Mater.
- ◆ Clubs **SHOULD** hold signs representing the club or class at the rallies.

PERFORMING/COMPETING GROUP CONTRACTS

- ◆ Must be submitted for every group that performs or competes an any capacity.
- ◆ If forms are not submitted and on file by September 27, performances, fieldtrips, etc., will be denied.
- ◆ All performing and competing students will be entered into the Extra-Curricular Activities Data Base and a weekly attendance report will be generated.
- ◆ 10 absences and 20 tardies (excused or unexcused) will permanently make a student ineligible to participate in extra-curricular activities for the remainder of the year.

TUTORING

- ◆ City year provides tutoring Monday – Thursday in the media center from 2:30 to 3:30.
- ◆ Club members who are on probation for GPA (lower than a 2.0) must attend tutoring.

UNITED WAY

- ◆ October 3 – October 13
- ◆ Each club is asked to raise and donate at LEAST \$10.00 to the United Way (you can raise more.)
- ◆ **One service point will be awarded for every dollar that is donated.**
- ◆ Clear all fundraising ideas through the Activities Office prior to starting.
- ◆ Deposit money with the school treasurer in the United Way Account. Make all checks payable to Miami Southridge Sr. High School.
- ◆ Give me the yellow copy of the check requisition as proof of deposit.
