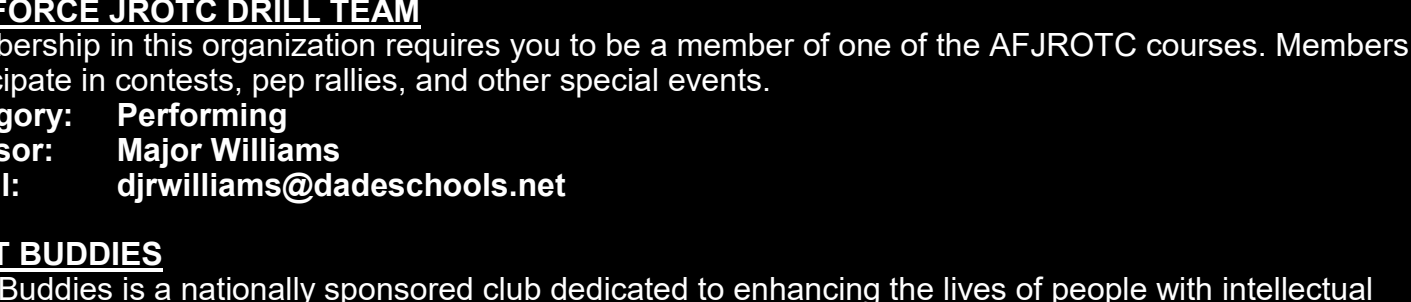


STUDENT ACTIVITIES
