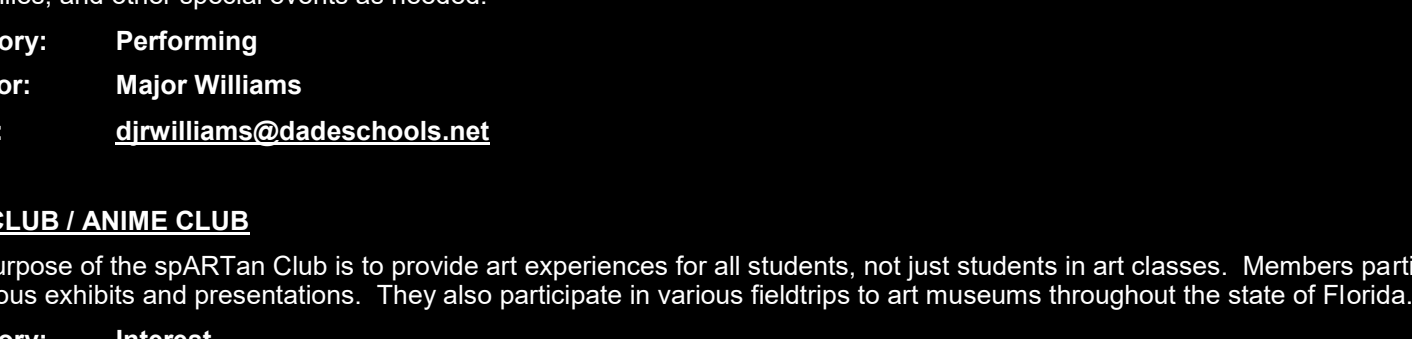


STUDENT ACTIVITIES
