TRANSPORTATION

BUS

- If your bus information is NOT available on your portal, please e-mail Mr. Morales at amorales 1@dadeschools.net.


PARENT DROP OFF

- Parents may drop off in the front of the school.
- ABSOLUTELY NO parent drop off is allowed in the Faculty Parking Lot (south side of school).
- No pedestrian access in Faculty Parking Lots

STUDENT DRIVERS

- Parking lot gates close at 7:45
- Parking lot gates open at 12:45 p.m. for students who have Work Experience.
- Park in assigned rows and locations.
- You must have a Driver's License, NOT a Learner's Permit to drive to school.
- Students must register their cars and will receive a permit for parking. These forms will be available next week at the Activities Office.
- Parking permits cost \$10.00.
- Student drivers MUST park in the Student Parking Lot. You are NOT permitted to park in the Staff Parking Lot or on the perimeter of the school. You car may be ticketed or towed.

ATTENDANCE

ABSENCES FROM SCHOOL

Absence 1 − 10:

- Students must bring a note within 3 days of an absence.
- Notes are to be submitted to the Attendance Office; include the student's ID number on the note. If a note is NOT provided, the absence will remain unexcused.

11 or more Absences:

- Official documentation must be provided within 5 days for every absence.
- Personal notes from parents will NOT be accepted.
- ALL absences will remain unexcused without documentation.

ATTENDANCE

TARDY TO SCHOOL

- Students will report to the auditorium for processing from 7:25 a.m. To 8:35 a.m.
- After 8:35 a.m., all students will report to the Attendance Office.
- Students that reach the 5th tardy will be escorted to and will remain in SCSI for the remainder of 1st block.

LATE ARRIVAL

- Students are to be counted in attendance only if they are physically present for at least two (2) hours of the day.
- Students must arrive no later than 12: 25 pm.

EARLY SIGN-OUTS

• Early sign-outs conclude at 1:55 pm. No students shall be released within the final thirty (30) minutes of the school day.

ATTENDANCE CONSEQUENCES

ABSENCES

- 10 or more absences may result in credit being withheld & will prevent student from participating in extra-curricular activities.
- All absences are unexcused until proper documentation has been submitted.

TARDY TO SCHOOL

- Accrued tardies will result in disciplinary actions.
- 20 or more tardies will prevent student from participating in any extracurricular activities and class and club events.

TOPS

DRESS CODE

- The following items MAY NOT BE WORN:
- NO hats or hoods may be worn in any building or classroom.
- No earbuds or headphones in the hallway.
- NO headwear of any kind.
- NO sleep wear, bedroom shoes, pajamas, or slippers.
- NO dog collars, motorcycle chains, two or three finger rings, or spikes.
- NO colors, symbols, national pendants or items associated with gangs (this includes bandanas)



STUDENT IDS
